MKC MARIBOR



The renovation of the Administrative Building of the Maribor Youth Cultural Center (MKC Maribor), which is part of the Cultural Center (KC) Pekarna, with which Hostel Pekarna (HOP) was arranged in the lower floors, started in 2009, and Hostel Pekarna officially opened its doors on the 21st. September 2011.

The investment in youth tourism infrastructure was the partially financed by Union's **ERDF** European (European Fund for Regional **Development)** and the Ministry of Education and Sports, as part of the Operational Program for Strengthening Regional Development Potentials for the period 2007 to 2013.

RENOVATION OF MARIBOR SKATEPARK

With the renovation of the Skate Park - co-financed by the ERDF programme, young people are enabled to participate in sports activities in a better and safer way. A multi-purpose facility was established, where organizations and associations offer young people opportunities for:

- active participation in sports in a safe and healthy environment;
- providing young people with high-quality extracurricular sports activities;
- in accordance with the principles of sustainable development, creating a stimulating environment for the development of various forms of sports activity for all groups of the population, their socialising and spending their free time (playgrounds, parks, nature trails, etc.);



DELAT GREM!

The Project "I'm going to work!" offers young people between the ages of 15 and 29 a set of different trainings, through which the participants strengthen various skills and competences and thus increase their employment opportunities.

The trainings are both in the field of personal growth and assertiveness, as well as very practical trainings related to the development of ideas that young people have, meetings with potential employers and the possibility of training at various employers.



The project is divided into three content sections: the **Library** of Knowledge, the Bank of Connections and Developing Young Dreams, and each of them offers young people a different type of training:





The knowledge library offers participants an introduction to the international method of the Living Library, used for the purpose of presenting various employment stories. Participants have the opportunity to learn and be inspired from work of various employers and entrepreneurs who will participate in the Living Library.

The bank of connections offers participants quality training in the field of project work, the possibility of developing their own ideas and the opportunity to learn about work at different employers,

The development of young dreams is divided into two subsections:

- Weekly trainings that will offer young people concrete, practical knowledge about what competencies and tools they need to enter the labor market (CV writing, digital tools, communication..)
- Creative and cultural industries, which will offer young people the skills training and the space to develop their own creativity.















The Future Fair Event and all outreach activities were organised by the **Development council of cohesion region East Slovenia** under the framework of the YOUTHopia Project, a pan European campaign led by the **Assembly of European Regions** to shed lights on the benefits of Cohesion Policy for young people in Europe's Regions.
